General Poster Instructions

- Poster boards are four feet high and eight feet wide (4' x 8'). They are made to accept push pins or Velcro fasteners, which you must supply.
- Poster material must be prepared in advance and be large enough to be viewed from a distance of three feet (90 cm.)
- Each poster must have a label at the top listing the title of the paper and the names and affiliations of authors. Characters in the title must be at least one inch (2.5 cm) high.
- Drawings should be simple with bold lines.
- Supply your own push pins or Velcro fasteners for mounting materials to poster boards.
- Authors must be at their posters during all designated poster sessions and must be available to answer questions during the period specifically prescribed for the presentation of their posters.
- ASBMR accepts no liability for posters or poster materials and will not adjudicate disputes between abstract presenters.
- Please note that children 12 years of age and under will not be permitted in the poster area or the exhibit hall at any time.
- Posters must be removed during the dismantling hours. **Posters that remain after that time will be discarded.**
