ADVOCATING FOR PATIENTS AND RESEARCH

33 volunteer leaders advocated and visited 37 congressional offices representing 17 states and 11 congressional districts at the February 2020 Capitol Hill Day

A Voice in Washington

ASBMR brought to elected representatives in Capitol Hill two specific asks:

- 1. Support of a \$3 billion increase to the U.S. National Institutes of Health (NIH) budget
- 2. Support bills H.R. 2693/S. 283 to increase the Medicare reimbursement rate for office-based dual-energy X-ray absorptiometry (DXA)





Realized a \$2.6 billion increase for FY2020 of the NIH budget over FY2019



Issued **14 legislative action alerts** that resulted in 208 U.S. members contacting their elected representatives to advocate for science in 2020
