In order to promote interest in the field of rare bone disease research and to recognize the excellent work being done by young investigators in this field, the Rare Bone Disease Patient Network, with the support of the American Society for Bone and Mineral Research, is pleased to provide Young Investigator Travel Awards to attend the Rare Bone Disease Research Summit on September 18-19, 2012 in Baltimore, Maryland.

Investigators will be asked to provide a poster for display at the Summit. Please provide a 250-400 word abstract that describes your basic, clinical, or translational research directly related to rare bone diseases such as osteogenesis imperfecta, fibrous dysplasia, XLH, hypophosphatasia, fibrodysplasia ossificans progressive, melorheostosis, skeletal implacations of Gorham's disease or other rare bone diseases.
